<p>Write 20 sight words spelled correctly on small strips of paper. Arrange them faceup on the floor. Have a family member say a word. Find it, say it out loud and swat it with a flyswatter. Can you do it in less than 5 seconds?</p>	<p>Listen to a nonfiction text. Choose one sentence that stands out to you and supports the main topic of the text. In your journal, draw a picture that represents that sentence. Then write the sentence in your own words.</p>	<p>Would you rather eat a hamburger or a piece of pizza? Write a paragraph in your journal explaining your answer. Then draw a picture of yourself eating the food you chose.</p>	<p>Think of 10 pairs of rhyming words, e.g. ball, tall. Write each word on a small piece of paper. Mix them up and put them facedown. Play a game of <i>Memory</i> with a family member, matching the rhyming words.</p>
<p>Listen to a picture book. In your journal, describe the problem faced by the main character. List the actions they took to solve the problem. What feelings do these specific actions show, e.g. sad, scared, happy, curious?</p>	<p>Write a poem about a teddy bear. In your poem, use the words four, roar and more. Make an illustration to go along with your poem. Read your poem to a family member.</p>	<p>Create 5 new cereal flavours that use alliteration, e.g. Bursting Blueberry Bubblegum. What would each cereal include? Draw a picture of each cereal box. Have your family vote on their favourite flavour.</p>	<p>Listen to a picture book. Think about the setting. Change the time and place of the story. In your journal, draw a picture showing the new setting. List the parts of the text that would be different because of the change.</p>
<p>What do you want to be when you grow up? Research the job and write 3 facts about it. Use the information to create an advertisement trying to recruit others to the profession. Show the ad to a family member.</p>	<p>Cut out the Letter Tiles and place them facedown. With a family member, play a game of <i>Scrabble</i>. Each player gets 7 tiles. Take turns building words by using at least one letter from another word that has been played.</p>	<p>Listen to a picture book. Choose 1 event that you think was the most important in the text. Draw a picture of it in your journal. Write a paragraph explaining why you think it was the most important. Retell the event to a family member.</p>	<p>Play a game of <i>I Spy</i> with a family member. Choose an object. Then give a clue about the object's position in relation to another object that includes a preposition, e.g. I spy something that is sitting <u>on</u> the table. Take turns giving clues.</p>



<p>Get 2 coloured markers, a pair of dice and a 100 chart. Take turns with someone rolling the dice to find the sum, then move the matching number of spaces on the chart. Colour the number. The first one to 100 wins!</p>	<p>Play <i>Battleship</i> with someone. Use a box lid as a divider. Each player uses small items to claim a group of 2, 3 and 4 numbers on a 100 chart. Take turns calling out numbers. The opponent says 'hit' or 'miss'.</p>	<p>Pick 3 rooms in your home. Using your feet, measure around the walls to find out how big each room is. In your journal, list the rooms and their lengths in order from smallest to largest.</p>	<p>Count all of the doorknobs in your home. Count all of the drawer handles. In your journal, make a bar graph showing the results. Compare the numbers using $<$, $>$, or $=$.</p>
<p>Using playdough, create a circle, square, rectangle and triangle. Cut each shape into 2 equal pieces. Put them back together and cut them into 4 equal pieces. Draw a picture of each one in your journal.</p>	<p>Remove the 10s and face cards from a deck of cards. Play <i>War</i> with a family member. Take 2 cards and subtract. The player with a difference (answer) closer to 0 keeps the cards.</p>	<p>Have a family member write the numbers 0–120 counting by 5s on small pieces of paper. Then ask them to hide all the numbers. Find all of the numbers and put them in order starting with 0.</p>	<p>Cut out the 7 shapes on the <i>Tangram Template</i>. Make the following items, using all 7 pieces: triangle, square, house, airplane and sailboat. What other items can you make? Have a family member guess each one.</p>
<p>Draw a picture of each type of money coin in your country. Write the value on each coin. Then cut them out and put them in order from the greatest value to the least value. Show a family member.</p>	<p>Remove the 10s and face cards from a deck of cards. Select the top two cards and make a 2-digit number. Write the number in your journal. Then draw it using a Base-10 pictorial model. Repeat 7 more times.</p>	<p>Find a twig and a rock outside. Have someone draw a line, using chalk. Measure the line by using the twig. Then measure it using the rock. Explain in your journal why your measurements are different.</p>	<p>Write down the age of each person in your family, including your own. Make an open number line on the floor by using tape. Then, place each number where it belongs. Show it to a family member.</p>

Use your diagram to explain the cycle to a family member.</p>	<p>Using only emojis or symbols, make a list of your top 5 strengths. Show your list to a family member. Can they guess each strength by looking at your symbols?</p>	<p>Think about the rules at school in your classroom. What are 3 rules you feel are important and help everyone? Tell them to a family member and explain why you think each one is important.</p>
<p>Have a family member use a piece of chalk to draw 4 large circles outside. Number the circles 1-4. Standing about 10 steps from the first circle, throw a small rock at the circles. Can you make it into each circle?</p>	<p>Head outside with a family member and a soft ball. Draw 2 circles about 6 feet apart. Each player stands in a circle. Throw the ball back and forth, trying to get it into the other circle but keeping it out of your own.</p>	<p>It's time to race a family member! Place a blown-up balloon between your knees and race across the room without dropping it. Then try it going backwards. Be sure not to squeeze too tightly!</p>	<p>Find at least 3 types of soil that look different either by size, texture or colour. Draw 3 circles in your journal. Fill each one with glue. Sprinkle each soil type in a different circle. Write a description of each one.</p>




Sphere


Triangular Pyramid



Cylinder





Square Pyramid
