Choose 4 activities to complete off of the Learning Grid

<p>Read or listen to a picture book. Create a bookmark for the text. On one side, describe the main character, setting and theme of the text. On the other side, draw 5 of your favourite scenes from the story. Be creative!</p>	<p>Which book character would you most want to meet? Write 6 interview questions you would ask them. Write a paragraph describing the character and explaining why you want to meet them.</p>	<p>Make up 5 new flavours of potato chips by using alliteration, e.g. Fancy Fish Flesh Flavour, Crunchy Carrot Cake Crumble. Draw and colour a picture of each flavour. Have your family members vote for their favourite one!</p>	<p>Search your home for items with 1, 2, 3, and 4 syllables. Try to find an item with 5 or more syllables. Write them in your journal. Then separate each word into syllables, e.g. choc-o-late, tel-e-vi-sion.</p>
<p>Find an advertisement in a magazine or newspaper. Make a T-chart in your journal, listing all of the facts and opinions that it contains.</p>	<p>Write a thank you note to someone in your home. How have they helped with your learning at home experience?</p>	<p>Plan a trip to another country. Create an itinerary and a budget. Be sure to include airfare, hotel, food, and entertainment into your budget. Share your plans for the trip with your family.</p>	<p>Research the distance between your country's capital city and 5 other capital cities in Australia. Order the distances from the shortest to the longest.</p>
<p>Using a piece of paper, make number cards 1-15. Turn the cards face down. Flip 3 cards over. Can you make 21 using all three numbers? Try again. HINT: Try using any combination of the 4 operations.</p>	<p>Find 3 recipes and see if they contain fractions. Make a list of each one (including the ingredient) in your journal. Draw a pictorial model beside each fraction. Be sure to label your model.</p>	<p>In your journal, write down the age of everyone in your home. For each person, create a multi-step word problem using their age as the answer.</p>	<p>Design a park for your neighbourhood. Where is the best location for it? Think about the direction of the sun and keeping it off any busy streets. Create a map of your neighbourhood and put the new park on it.</p>
